## **Standard of Conduct for all Campers**

1. Must attend all day and evening services.
2. Must not leave the services until dismissed, except to go to the bathroom, or for illness.
3. All campers to sit in their assigned areas. Boys and girls will not sit together during the day or the evening services.
4. No pairing off of boys and girls. No holding hands, kissing, etc.
5. No hitting, kicking, fighting, etc.
6. Profanity, smoking, alcoholic beverages, drugs, tobacco products, matches, cigarettes and /or lighters (or any other flaming instrument) are not allowed.
7. Knives, guns, chains, or any other instruments used harmfully are not allowed.
8. Rock, rap, country/western, Christian rock, and alternative music is not allowed.
9. Portable electronic devices such as Ipads, MP3 players, CD players, computers and cell phones will not be allowed during the after-service activities. Please use the following contact numbers if you have an emergency and need to contact your child:
  - A phone number for a chaperone from your church; or,
  - Call the Faith Tabernacle office at (785) 238-2988.
10. Must respectfully obey Camp Staff at all times.
11. Stealing or damaging property of other campers is strictly prohibited.
12. Sale of unauthorized food, drinks, or products is not allowed.
13. Pets are not allowed.
14. Campers are to obey all adults and show due honor and respect. If you feel an adult has mistreated you, present your issue to a Camp Chaperone.

\*These rules are given as Minimum Guidelines for every camper. This code of conduct has been written for your protection and to benefit all in attendance. They are to be obeyed at all times. You have pledged yourself by signing the enrollment form to abide by this code during this camp. Failure to do so will make you subject to disciplinary action. No camper sent home is to return for any reason.

## ***Heartland Youth Camp***

### **Standard of Dress for All Campers and Staff**

#### **Girls and Ladies**

1. Skirt length must be below the calf at all times, with no slits or uneven hems.
2. No pants or shorts.
3. Sleeves must be at least  $\frac{3}{4}$  length, and below the elbow at all times.
4. No tight or sheer clothing.
5. No low neck lines.
6. No bellybutton or mid-riff shirts. (when arms are raised, no flesh should be exposed).
7. No low hip skirts. (abdomen should not be visible at any time).
8. No jewelry or rings of any kind.
9. No makeup or nail polish of any kind.
10. Hosiery and dress attire must be worn to evening services.
11. No baseball caps are to be worn.

#### **Boys and Men**

1. No shorts.
2. No jewelry or rings of any kind.
3. No tight or sheer clothing.
4. Must be clean shaven.
5. Must have a nice haircut, with hair off the forehead, collar and ears.
6. Sleeves must be at least  $\frac{3}{4}$ -length, and below the elbow at all times.
7. No bellybutton or mid-riff shirts. (when arms are raised, no flesh should be exposed).
8. No baggy or low-hanging pants.
9. Dress attire must be worn to evening services.
10. No Jogger pants are allowed.

**\*\* All youth must wear non-marking shoes at Riddle Hall/JC Hight School.**
